OUR JANUARY MEETING

Attendance: 51 Present 17 Apologies 4 AWOL 4 Visitors

President: Brian Mellady advised that nomination forms for 2019-2020 Committee positions are available today. Nominations must be with the Secretary by **11th February 2019**. Members will recall that David Woodlock resigned as auditor in November 2018 and we thanked him for his services to the Club. Your Executive Committee met on 7th January with Bernie Edwards who is qualified to audit our accounts and we have therefore engaged him. Treasurer Andy will arrange to meet with Bernie so that the audit for the last Probus financial year can be completed. Brian then welcomed four visitors, three of these are expressing interest in joining the Club. He welcomed Henry Hammond back, having recovered from his recent health issues.

<u>Investment</u>: Max Batchelor advised that Bette Wilson was the winner of 2018 ASX All Ords Index Tipping Competition with tip of 6167 which was 8% above actual of 5709 (the late Diane Griffiths was the real winner with 5865)

Seventeen members have submitted portfolios for the 2019 competition. At this early stage David Woodlock was up 7.6% and Bob Graham up 7.4%. Interested members were invited to attend the lunch meeting to see what happens. (*three actually turned up with possibly two new likely starters*). At the lunch meeting members are invited to vote on the selection of a hypothetical portfolio of five shares which would be set up as a Group Portfolio to create extra interest. December was a bad market for the stock-market with all shares well down but since Christmas things are back to normal increasing by 6.8% including 2.8% in previous week.
